Coconut milk soap



Ingredients

150 g apricot kernel oil 30 g almond oil 20 g castor oil 180 g coconut oil 20 g cocoa butter 140 g coconut milk (frozen) 58 g NaOH

6 - 8 g cedarwood essential oil

Color: a little cinnamon or iron oxide (brown)

Other

- wooden sticks
- for this soap you need a mold with a capacity of about 500 - 600 g
- the coconut milk (can) should be frozen one day before, I empty it for this an ice cube tray

Preparation

- 1. Melt solid fats and mix with liquid oils.
- 2. Melt frozen coconut milk with NaOH. This process may take a few minutes. The liquor will not be as hot compared to dissolving in a liquid. Work carefully so that no lye crystals remain in the coconut milk that are not dissolved!
- 3. Once the coconut milk is dissolved, mix it with the oils and fats (40 45 °C). When a slight trace can be seen, set aside a little soap glue for the brown marbling.
- 4. Pour the white soap glue completely into the mold. Color the soap glue set aside brown and draw fine lines on the surface.
- 5. Using a wooden chopstick, draw the classic Esterhazy pattern in S lines.
